# Race Information

2024

Welcome to Nordenskiöldsloppet. This is important information for you as a participant, you will also find answers to questions concerning the race.

## Pre-Start

### Registration

At the registration at Gamla Apoteket, you will receive the following:

#### **1. Race information**

#### **2. Bib number**

**3. Two Chips** for timing during the race.

#### **4. Bags/sacks for packing: three colors and Checkpoints:**

White bag: CP Bälkasgårrö

Gray bag: CP Njavve

Black bag: Finish area in Jokkmokk

### Bag Drop

Drop off white and gray bag at the Ski stadium on Friday, 22/3, between 12:00 and 22:00. The white bag goes to Bälkasgårrö. The gray bag goes to Njavve.

## Pre-Start

### SkiGo Waxing service

With pre-booked SkiGo's waxing package, hand in skis at Samelandsresor (on the other side of E45 at the ski stadium). Thursday, 21/3, 18:00-21:00 and Friday, 22/3, 8:00-18:00.

### Competition Rules

Rules of the Swedish Ski Association and FIS apply.

### Starting order

Starting order for non-elite skiers are divided into two starting groups; with estimated race time over or under 17 hours.

## Start

### Start Time

The race starts at 05:00. The start area will be open from 03:45

### Start Area

Entrances to the start area are located at the ski stadium and west of Hotel Jokkmokk. Address: Kvarnbogatan.

### Chip registration

Your timing chips need to be registered. Checkpoint is available at the entrances.

### Bag Drop

Put clothes to be collected at the finish line and overgarments in the black bag. Drop off at the designated location in the start area.

## Race

### Checkpoints and Cut-off times

In addition to the start and finish, there are 17 drink / food checkpoints. Hot meals are served at the checkpoints in Granudden (2 times), Njavve, and Purkijaur. The maximum race time is 30 hours. Additional cut-off times apply at each checkpoint. See the race website under the tab "About the Race" for current cut-off times.

## Race

### Service at Checkpoints

In addition to drinks and food, there are simpler self-service stations for waxing at all checkpoints. Spare poles and basic repair equipment are available at the checkpoints

### Recommended Personal Equipment

Hydration belt, headlamp, and close-fitting goggles.

### Abort the race

If you break off the race, you must go to the nearest checkpoint. Return your timing chip, report your break off and the checkpoint will arrange transport to Jokkmokk.

## Race

### Medical Service

Medical personnel and equipment are available at the checkpoints.

### Service Track

Parallel to the ski track, there is a service track used by the race organization. The service track can also be used by service teams.

Snowmobile driving is not allowed on the ski track at any point.

### Littering

Litter from participants must be thrown in the bins at checkpoints, not along the track.

### Spectators

Spectators along the course are primarily referred to visit checkpoints in Njavve, Granudden, and Purkijaur.

## Finish

### Chip Return

Return timing chips in the finish area. A fee applies for chips not returned

### Medal

The time limit for a medal is the winning time of 1884: 21 hours and 22 minutes.

### Changing Room / Shower

Changing rooms and showers are available at Västra Skolan. Follow signs from the finish area.

### Transport from Finish Area

Transportation by car/minibus is available in the finish area for local transportation in Jokkmokk. No pre-book.

## General

- Participation in race is at your own risk.

-The race organization has the right to stop participants in case of health risks

-The race officials are there to help you complete the race. Your support to fellow participants during the race is important for everyone to enjoy and reach the finish line in Jokkmokk.
